



## Mentoring Events Inform and Affirm Young Women

The Luce Policy Institute's staff, board and close advisors are involved in mentoring America's most promising young women. The Luce Policy Institute hosts several high school and college mentoring lunches each year as a way to provide support and reach young women with conservative ideas. Mentoring lunch participants return to their campuses invigorated and ready to take leadership roles in their communities. These events give young women the unique opportunity to talk to other conservative women their age and to meet prominent women leaders. As one young woman stated, "Not only was there a wonderful dialogue and mentoring, I met dozens of young women who feel the same way as I do — I didn't know anyone else my age believed the same things I did."

## Tackling the Tough Issues

Often the major news organizations call on the leaders of radical feminist groups to speak for American women. The Clare Boothe Luce Policy Institute is engaged in a massive effort to educate the media and Americans on these phony leaders. Radical feminists claim to speak for all women, but their top priorities and views are inconsistent with those of most American women. Luce Policy Institute staff members appear on talk radio and television programs and write scores of opinion and policy op-ed pieces for national publications. From coast to coast, Americans are hearing from Institute staff members and speakers who offer common sense views and meaningful answers. The women featured in the 2006 Great American Conservative Women Calendar are just a few of the many conservative women role models provided by the Luce Policy Institute. They represent the majority of women in America who believe in the importance of freedom, faith and family. Many of these leaders are also featured in the Luce Policy Institute's book, *Great American Conservative Women*. Nationally syndicated radio show host Rush Limbaugh said, "It's long past due that someone put together a collection of ideas and philosophies from conservative women in print. **Clare Boothe Luce** was a foreign and domestic journalist, magazine editor, playwright, Congresswoman from Connecticut and Ambassador to Italy. She was a leader in the free world's opposition to communism, an outspoken advocate of free enterprise and a woman devoted to her family. Born just three years after the turn of the century, her astounding personal and public accomplishments made it natural that the title "The Woman of the Century" was bestowed upon her after her death.
